Junior League of Boise Appointment of 95th President for the 2023 Fiscal Year

BOISE, ID -- The Junior League of Boise (JLB), a non-profit organization of women volunteers that has served the Treasure Valley since 1928, is proud to announce today HannaLore Hein of Boise had been appointed President of the League for the 2023 fiscal year effective June 1. The office of the Junior League President is an annual appointment slated by the organization's Nominations Committee and confirmed by the active membership.

Miss Hein, an active member of the Junior League since May 2016, served on the 90th Anniversary Committee in 2018 and the Member Impact Team, responsible for member recruitment and retention, in 2019. More recently, she chaired the League's Advancement Team, which saw diversification in fundraising efforts under her leadership. Her previous Board positions include Nominations Committee Chair and President-elect. Miss Hein has held many leadership positions with the League because "each position offered a unique opportunity to strengthen or acquire new leadership skills all while giving back to my community," said Hein.

"The mission of the Junior League, which recognizes the importance of developing the potential of women *through* volunteer work, means that by serving in this organization, and helping propel the League forward, I am inherently gaining experiences and skills *by doing*. And my community is the beneficiary of my leadership development. I am privileged and honored to serve as the League's 95th president, knowing that many of Boise's most prominent women leaders served in this capacity before me--and that they cut their teeth in the Junior League before going on to do even more impactful work in the Treasure Valley." In addition to her volunteer service with the Junior League, Miss Hein works professionally as the Idaho State Historian with the Idaho State Historical Society.

The JLB also announced that Kristen Schroeder has been appointed President-elect for the 2023 Fiscal Year and will serve concurrently on the Board of Directors and serve as Chair of the League's Management Team, the entity responsible for daily operations. Mrs. Schroeder is a resident of Meridian and has been a member of the JLB since 2017. Additional Members of the Board confirmed by the membership for

The Board of Directors is responsible for making governance decisions for the Junior League of Boise and leads on behalf of the entire membership.
